

107 years ago, a group of dedicated volunteers came together to make a difference in health care in the Clarington community.





# Spotlight: Community Partner

SHOPPERS DRUG MART - GROWING WOMEN'S HEALTH CAMPAIGN

In 2017, three local **Shoppers Drug Mart – Longworth Avenue, Highway #2, Bowmanville Mall** – rose to the challenge with a **\$120,000 pledge** to purchase a new, state-of-the-art Computer Assisted Diagnosis (CAD) system for the Mammography Department at Bowmanville Hospital. 
