On December 6, 2018, at a special Press Conference, the **Association of Hospital Volunteers - Bowmanville** announced a **\$1,000,000 gift** to the Bowmanville Hospital.

The majority of the Hennessey family still resides in and close to Peterborough and several of Kathleen's descendants reside throughout the Greater Toronto Area, including Clarington. Kathleen's grandson, Steve Hennessey, currently sits on the Foundation's Board of Directors. The Foundation is very grateful to Steve and his family for demonstrating such a deep commitment to the health of our community and for reinforcing the true spirit of philanthropy.

## ESTATE

### *Mary Fletcher Estate*

In April 2018, the Foundation received a phenomenal **\$196,000** from the Estate of Mrs. Mary Fletcher. The funds were split with the majority going to support the redevelopment and expansion project and the remainder to support the area of greatest need at Bowmanville Hospital.



Mary was a long-time supporter of Bowmanville Hospital and had regularly donated to the Foundation since 1989. She sat on the Foundation's volunteer Board of Directors for more than 10 years and supported many initiatives including the "New to You" retail store operated by the Association of Hospital Volunteers – Bowmanville. After moving to Bowmanville in the mid-1980s, Mary and her husband, Vince, became long-time members of the Rotary Club of Bowmanville, and exemplified philanthropic spirit in all of their community involvement.

The Foundation is incredibly grateful to be a part of Mary's long philanthropic history in Bowmanville and to share her legacy at Bowmanville Hospital with this generous contribution.



# Spotlight: Community Partner

SHOPPERS DRUG MART - GROWING WOMEN'S HEALTH CAMPAIGN

In 2017, three local **Shoppers Drug Mart – Longworth Avenue, Highway #2, Bowmanville Mall** – rose to the challenge with a **\$120,000 pledge** to purchase a new, state-of-the-art Computer Assisted Diagnosis (CAD) system for the Mammography Department at Bowmanville Hospital. Shoppers Drug Mart at Garden Street & Taunton Road would later join the trio, combining the funds raised through their initiatives.

As part of Shoppers Drug Mart Corporation's commitment to improving the health of all Canadian women - body, mind and spirit - the funds donated through the local Growing Women's Health campaign will support women's health initiatives at Bowmanville Hospital. To date, Shoppers Drug Mart has donated more than \$18,000 toward their 10-year pledge commitment.

Formerly known as the Tree of Life initiative, the Growing Women's Health campaign is a four-week program held across Canada and is one of the leading partnership programs of the SHOPPERS LOVE. YOU. platform.

"When the decision came to support Bowmanville Hospital, it was an obvious choice," said Ms. Leanne Travis, Pharmacist Owner, Shoppers Drug Mart, Longworth Avenue. "The Hospital is vital to our community.
